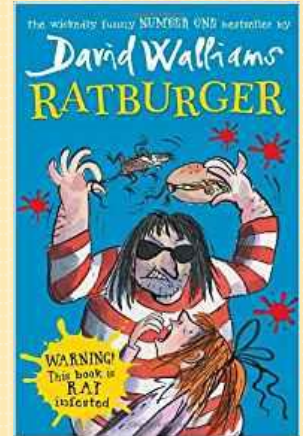


EXTRA MILE CHALLENGE
