Tuesday 4th September

- * £5 - diary/planner and a locker key - bring a key ring or lanyard for the key.
- * Correct uniform, including black shoes.
- * PE kit in a named bag – stored in locker ready for their first PE/Games lesson.

Tuesday 4th September

Drinks and snacks

- * Named water bottle – only water.
- * Water bottles can be refilled at break or at lunchtime - not during a lesson.
- * Additional drinks – juice etc. only at lunchtime. No fizzy drinks.
- * Snacks – fruit or a biscuit (no crisps or chocolate at break time).



Holiday Tasks - English

- * Read as much as possible over the summer – books, magazines, newspaper articles, recipes, food labels etc.
- * Mrs Shannon, will be setting a challenge for the children to get a photograph of themselves reading in an unusual place.
- * Write about the photograph they are handing into Mrs Shannon, explaining where they are and what they are doing. No more than half a side of A4 paper.



Holiday Tasks – Maths

- * Tell the time –analogue watch/clock face (o'clock and half past).
- * Mental maths skills - number bonds to 20 (games eg. adding the digits on car registration plates), times tables and division facts, shape recognition etc.
- * Manga high – logins will be given to children on transfer day.

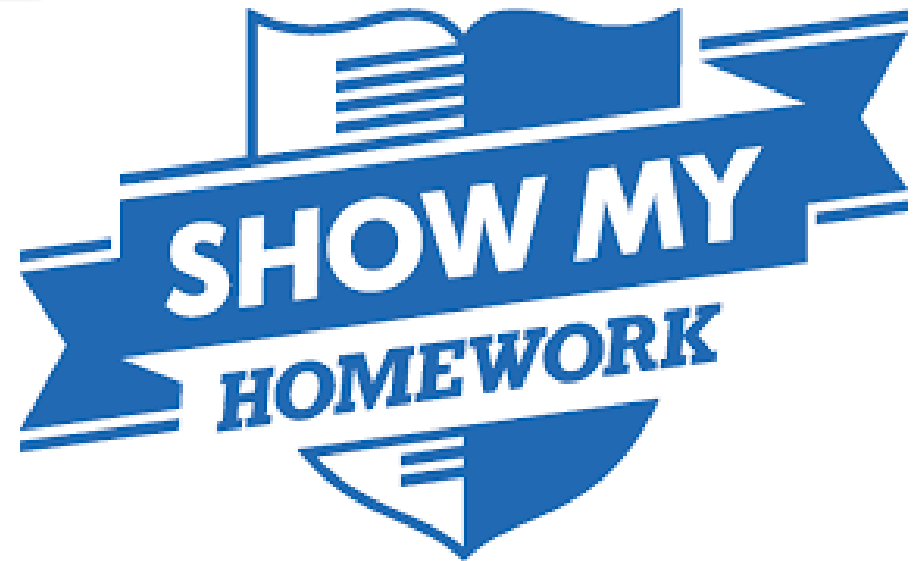
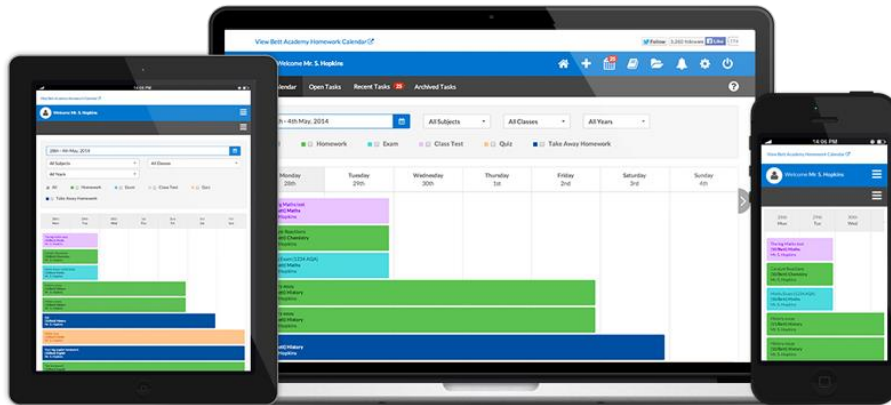
