

## SPORTS PREMIUM PLANNED SPEND 2018-2019

This funding is additional to the school budget funding and at Ferndown Middle School we are fortunate to employ well trained specialist teachers for physical education lessons. These teachers already offer an extensive and free programme of clubs and teams that extend beyond the school day. These are the traditional sports of football, rugby, netball, rounders, cricket, cross country, tennis and athletics.

We believe in maximum participation for all pupils and therefore we are using our funding to support the existing programme and to extend it further to include a variety of sports. With the aim to increase physical activity and to inspire more pupils to take up sport.
