| Year | Recipe | Ingredients |
|--------------|-----------------------------|--|
| Year 5 | Fruit Salad | Selection of apple, grapes, banana, kiwi fruit, orange/satsuma/clementine or any other fruit you like along with a small carton of apple/ orange juice. No whole pineapple or mangoes. |
| Year 6 Tues | Savoury Rolls | 250g strong flour, 1 tsp sugar, 1 rounded tbsp dried yeast or a sachet. Optional: Cheese/ Chorizo/ Pumpkin seeds/ Poppy seeds. |
| Year 6 Thurs | Cheese Straws | 100g plain flour, 50g marg, 50g cheese. If you have any shape cutters please bring them in. |
| Year 7 | Homemade Soup | 1 stock cube, 1 large or two medium onions, 2 other veg of your choice. Optional extras: pre-cooked meat, half a carton of double cream. |
| Year 8 | Garlic mushrooms and wedges | 2 large potatoes, 3 large eggs, 3/4 slices of older bread, 8 closed cup mushrooms. |
