Year 5 Thurs	Fruit Salad	Apple Grapes (any colour), Banana, kiwi fruit, orange, satsuma or clementine. Any other fruit you like. Small carton of orange/apple juice.
Year 6A/2 Tues	Quick Cheese Pizza	90g butter or marg, 30mls runny honey, 2 medium ripe bananas, 60g raisins or other dried fruit, 240g oats, 4 tsp ground cinnamon.
