Year	Recipe	Ingredients
Year 5	Banana or plain Muffins	100g butter, 100g caster sugar, 140g self-raising flour, 2 eggs, 1 medium ripe banana, 1 tsp vanilla essence, 10 paper cake cases. <i>*If you bring in 20p the school will provide paper cases and vanilla essence</i>
Year 6 Tues	Mac and Veg	100g dried pasta, macaroni or penne, 1 pepper, 1 small courgette, 100g frozen peas or sweetcorn or a mix, 4 eggs, 50g cheddar cheese, 2 tsp dried mixed herbs.
Year 6 Thurs	Blueberry Muffins	250g Plain Flour, 2 eggs, 175ml milk, 150ml sunflower oil, 100g blueberries, 12 muffin cases, 150g caster sugar.
Year 7	Samosas	Please bring in £1.50 in order to make 3-4 samosas in groups of 3 students. Without this money the whole class will not be able to cook.
Year 8A Mon	Shepherd's Pie	350g Quorn mince 1 medium onion 1 medium carrot 1 vegetable stock cube 4 large potatoes 2 medium sized parsnips 100g frozen peas.
8B1 Mon	Leek and Bacon Pasta Bake	2 med leeks, 4 rashers unsmoked bacon, 300g pasta shapes, 1 thick slice whole meal bread, 200g reduced fat soft cream cheese.
