



Vacancy for Community Governor

Thank you very much for your interest in becoming a Community governor at Ferndown Middle School (FMS).

School governance is strategic, not operational. The day-to-day running of the school is the responsibility of the Headteacher. The Headteacher fulfils this responsibility through implementing the strategic plan agreed with the governing board.

The role of community governor, is largely a thinking role, not a doing one, and as a member of the FMS School Standards Board (SSB), you will be responsible for monitoring standards, data, and pupil progress as well as financial oversight of the school.

Members of the SSB come from all walks of life and meet as a group at least once every half term, normally on a Wednesday at 17.00. During these meetings, we look at a wide range of information to find out how well the school is performing. The Headteacher provides a detailed report, but we also look at data and independent reports so that we can make our own decisions about how well the school is performing. In addition to this, governors are involved in important decisions around other aspects of the school such as curriculum and funding and strive to ensure the best outcomes for our pupils and families.

In between the formal meetings, governors will typically go into the school to meet with the Headteacher, other members of staff and pupils to help us find out how the school is progressing towards its development plan and targets.

We attend training sessions and seminars to help us keep up to date with changes in schools and education and to help us do our job effectively.

Governors receive no payment but there is a tremendous sense of satisfaction that each one is making a valuable contribution to the education of all the children who attend Ferndown Middle School.
