

**V = Vocabulary**      **“Find and explain the meaning of words in context.”**

- Look at the section headed “\_\_\_”. Find and copy one word which shows \_\_\_.
- Look at \_\_\_. Find and copy one word from the paragraph which has the closest meaning to \_\_\_.
- “Quote”. What does the word “\_\_\_” suggest about \_\_\_ ?
- Find a word in the text which means the same as “\_\_\_\_\_”.
- How do the words “\_\_\_”, “\_\_\_” and “\_\_\_” suggest about the character, setting or mood?
- Look at the word “\_\_\_”. What is a synonym for it? What is an antonym for it?
- Which word tells you that \_\_\_\_\_?

**I = Infer**      **“Make and justify inferences using evidence from the text.”**

- How do the words “\_\_\_” and “\_\_\_” make the reader feel?
- How does the description of \_\_\_ show that they are \_\_\_ ?
- What was \_\_\_ thinking when \_\_\_ ?
- What impression do you get of “character” from these paragraphs?
- In the last paragraph, why might the reader feel “emotion” for “character”?
- How can you tell that “character” was feeling “emotion”?
- What voice might “character” use? Why do you think this?
- What words suggest that “character” had “event in story”?

**P = Predict**      **“Predict what might happen from details given.”**

- From the cover, what do you think the text is going to be about?
- What do you think will happen next?
- How do you think the paragraph will add to the future of this book?
- Do you think \_\_\_ will happen? Yes, no or maybe? Explain your answer using evidence from the text.
- Let’s make a prediction on what may happen next... Now that we have read the text, was your prediction correct?
- How do you think “character’s action” will change the plot?

### **E = Explain “Explain how themes and patterns develop across the text.”**

- Why is the text arranged in this way? What is the purpose of each feature?
- Is the use of \_\_\_ effective?
- What is the author’s point of view?
- What effect does \_\_\_ have on the audience? Why do you think this?
- Find the sentence that is the turning point for the text. Explain why you think it was this group of words and what effect they had on the plot.
- Explain what the sentence “\_\_\_” means.
- Explain how “character’s actions” changed the plot.

### **R = Retrieve “Retrieve and record information using key details.”**

*These are the easiest questions. Ask any questions involving the 5Ws and H.*

- How did \_\_\_?
- What does \_\_\_ do in this part of the story?
- Why did \_\_\_ ?
- How \_\_\_ is \_\_\_ ?
- According to the text, what would happen if \_\_\_ ?
- How many \_\_\_ ?
- Who are \_\_\_ ?
- What adjectives were used to describe \_\_\_ ?

### **S = Summarise “Summarise the ideas from more than one paragraph.”**

- Summarise what has just happened in the last paragraph/page/chapter.
- In only one sentence, summarise what has just happened.
- Briefly summarise what has happened so far in the book.
- What two feelings does “character” have after “event”?
- If you were to summarise the chapter in 3 words, what words would you use?
- In 3 adjectives, summarise “character”. Why did you choose these?
- What happened after “event”?
