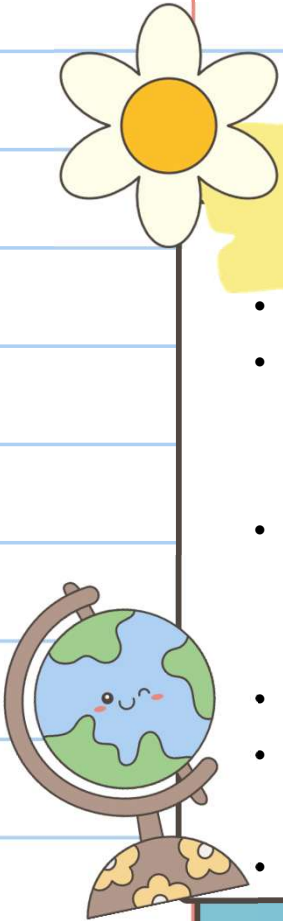
I really enjoy teaching and I am excited to get to know you all and support your children as they make this transition.

Equipment

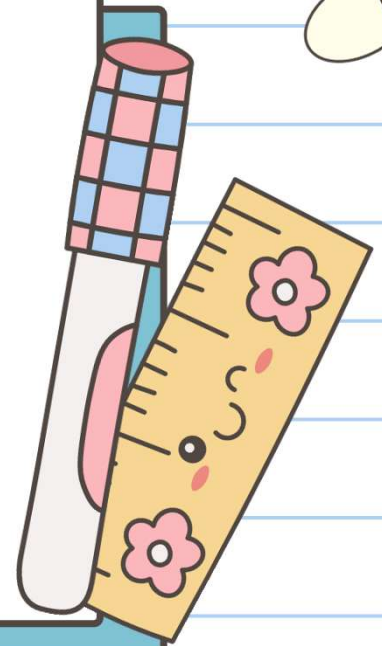
What to bring to school each day:

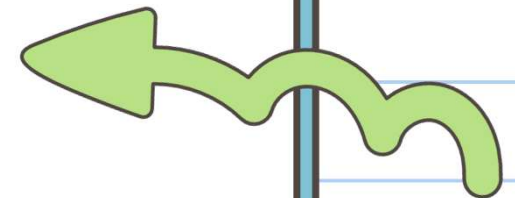
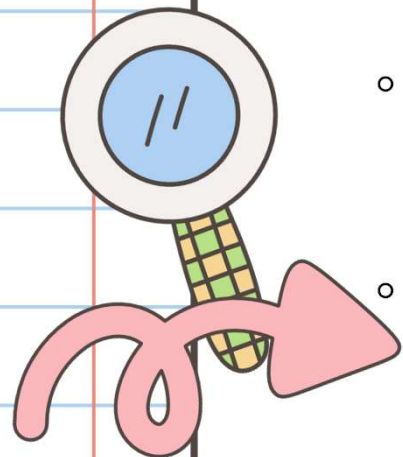
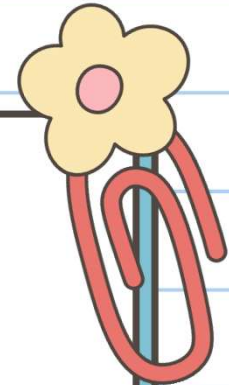
Fidget Tools & Other Learning Aids
